All dogs must be on leash at all times per AKC Tracking Regulations.

CLOSING DATE: Wednesday, May 14, 2008 at 6:00 pm, local time.

ENTRIES: Entry fee is \$100 for VST. Check or Canadian money orders in US dollars only. Entry fee includes \$.50 AKC Recording Fee. Checks should be made payable to Croix Valley Tracking Club. Do NOT send entries by any method requiring a signature for delivery. Mail entries to the Test Secretary: Robin Kilbury, 11235 Akron Avenue, Inver Grove Heights, MN 55077-5405. If you would like to receive confirmation of receipt of your entry, include a SASE OR a valid email address. Entries must be made on an official AKC entry form. *NOTE:* Dogs must have passed an AKC-TD to enter this test.

ENTRY DRAWING: Wednesday, May 14, 2008 at 8:00 pm local time at the home of the Test Secretary, 11235 Akron Avenue, Inver Grove Heights, MN 55077 to determine which dogs will participate. The public is invited. Entries for this test will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference will be given to those dogs that have not passed a VST test. When the advertised limit has been drawn all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth in the preceding sentence, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. The Test Secretary will then notify all entries of the result of the draw. Entry identification, a judging program and directions to the site will be sent to each entrant and alternate. In the event any of the accepted entries cancel or are absent on the day of the test, the Test Secretary will contact the alternates in the order of the drawing. Upon such notification, the alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing entry. If for any reason a dog making the draw is not present or cannot run, the fees will be refunded provided that an alternate competes in their place.

TEST HOURS: Monday, May 26, 2008, 5:00am to 5:00pm. The VST track order will be drawn by lot at 8:30 am with the first track running as soon as ready after the draw.

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. The handler must notify the Test Secretary prior to the drawing for track order on the day of the test.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in this test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. Croix Valley Tracking Club assumes no responsibility for any personal property, theft, injury or death of any animal or damage to any property while at this test of the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

DISASTER AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLAN: Croix Valley Tracking club has prepared such a plan for this event. The plan will be available at the test site on test day.
