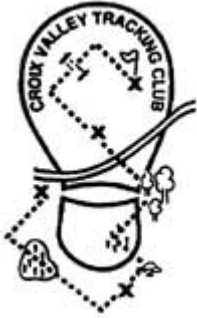

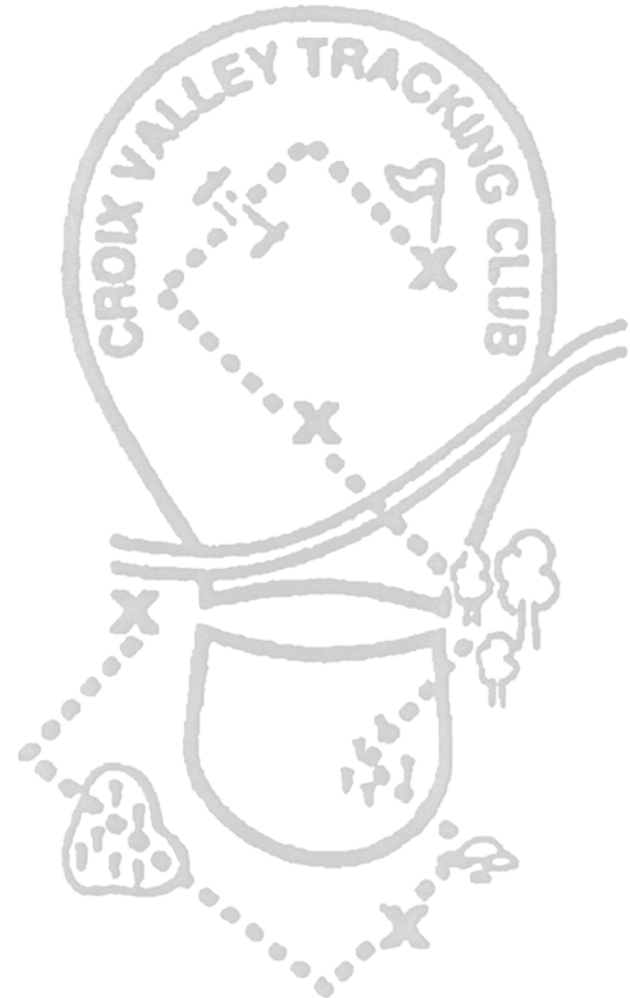

Test Site

Kinnickinnic State Park, River Falls, WI

The draw site will be at Kinnickinnic State Park picnic grounds

From Interstate Highway 94 in Hudson, go south on County Highway F. Go about 7.7 miles to Cedar View Road (820th Avenue). Turn right and go about 0.2 miles; the park entrance will be on your left. From U.S. Highway 10, go about 1.2 miles east of Prescott, go north on State Highway 29 about 1.2 miles to County Highway F. Turn left (north) onto County Highway F and go 5.2 miles to Cedar View Road (820th Avenue). Turn left and go about 0.2 miles; the park entrance will be on your left. Geographic coordinates are 44° 50' 14.10" N, 92° 44' 7.31" W. The test draw site is at the St Croix Picnic Area at the very end of the park's road.

Take 94 west, then take 694 N. Exit on the first exit, 10th St, N. Turn right on 10th St, N. Turn left on Helmo Ave, Turn right on 11th St. You will see the blue and white sign that reads Animal Emergency Clinic.

All dogs must be on leash at all times per AKC Tracking Regulations.

ENTRIES: Entry fee is \$65 for the TD. Check or Canadian money orders in US dollars only. Entry fee includes \$.50 AKC Recording Fee and \$3.00 Event Service Fee. Checks should be made payable to Croix Valley Tracking Club. Do NOT send entries by any method requiring a signature for delivery. Mail entries to the Test Secretary: **Mary Barker, 338 E. 6th Street, New Richmond, WI 54017.** All entrants will be notified upon receipt of entry by e-mail. Entries must be made on an official AKC entry form. **NOTE: Certification statement must be sent with entry forms for dogs that have not passed an AKC Tracking Dog test.** Entries without a TD title will be accepted first. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog.

ENTRY DRAWING: Thursday, October 12, 2017 at 6:00 pm local time to determine which dogs will participate. The public is invited - for directions contact the test secretary. Entries for this test will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. The test worker draw option as allowed by the AKC Tracking Regulations (Chap 1, Sec. 17d) will be used in this test for club members only as defined by the club's Board of Directors and voted on by the club members. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference will be given to those dogs that have not passed a TD test. When the advertised limit has been drawn all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth in the preceding sentence, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. The Test Secretary will then notify the entrant participant by phone and the alternate entrants by e-mail of the result of the draw. Entry identification, a judging program and directions to the site will be sent to each entrant and alternate. In the event any of the accepted entries cancel or are absent on the day of the test, the Test Secretary will contact the alternates in the order of the drawing. Upon such notification, the alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing entry. If for any reason a dog making the draw is not present or cannot run, the fees will be refunded provided that an alternate competes in their place.

TEST HOURS: Sunday October 22, 2017, 5:00am to 5:00pm. The Tracking Dog (TD) track order will be drawn by lot at 8:00 am with the first track running as soon as ready after the draw.

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. The handler must notify the Test Secretary prior to the drawing for track order on the day of the test.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in this test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. Croix Valley Tracking Club assumes no responsibility for any personal property, theft, injury or death of any animal or damage to any property while at this test, or in transit to or from the site.

DISASTER AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLAN: Croix Valley Tracking Club has prepared such a plan for this event. The plan will be available at the test site on test day.
